MGRC provides a safe and nurturing environment for the most at-risk Maasai girls who are orphaned and/or living in abusive conditions. ClarkeHopkinsClarke, has provided design expertise, site assessment, and significant local knowledge in developing the site masterplan for the new campus. MGRC plans to construct five homes on the permanent site in Karatu, eventually expanding to ten homes for 120 girls, with a playing field. Each home will shelter 12 girls and two house mothers. Girls will be grouped by age so they can help each other with schoolwork and learning life skills.
